

**SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE EXISTING GARBAGE
AND REFUSE ORDINANCE AND ENACTING A NEW ORDINANCE
WITHIN THE CITY OF CLINTON, STATE OF MINNESOTA**

In order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Clinton, the Clinton City Council hereby repeals Ordinance No. 11-90 dealing with garbage and refuse and hereby enacts a new Ordinance in its place. The new Ordinance covers the following topics: definition of terms; the type of container required and its placement; prohibiting meddling with other trash receptacles; requiring containers to be kept sanitary and secure; prohibiting unauthorized private collections; city options for sanitation service; removal of building materials; prohibited acts; nonresidential customers; container types; collection schedules; manner of collection and transportation; licensing for collection; and collection of leaves, tress, or tree limbs.

A violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1000) and/or up to ninety (90) days of jail.

This summary is being published in compliance with Minnesota Statutes Section 331A.01, Subdivision 10 and Minnesota Statutes Section 412.191, Subdivision 4. A copy of the full text of this Ordinance shall be available at regular office hours of the office of the Clinton City Clerk. The full text of this Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
