SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE EXISTING PUBLIC NUISANCE ORDINANCE AND ENACTING A NEW ORDINANCE WITHIN THE CITY OF CLINTON, STATE OF MINNESOTA

In order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Clinton, the Clinton City Council hereby repeals Ordinance No. 01-10 dealing with public nuisances and hereby enacts a new Ordinance in its place. The new Ordinance covers the following topics: what behavior constitutes a public nuisance; the abatement process for the City of Clinton to follow in order to declare and abate the public nuisance, including the declaration of an emergency for summary enforcement and emergency abatement; a resident's appeal process; and the City's ability to recover its costs incurred in abating the public nuisance.

A violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1000) and/or up to ninety (90) days of jail.

This summary is being published in compliance with Minnesota Statues Section 331A.01, Subdivision 10 and Minnesota Statutes Section 412.191, Subdivision 4. A copy of the full text of this Ordinance shall be available at regular office hours of the office of the Clinton City Clerk. The full text of this Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
