## SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE EXISTING WEEDS ORDINANCE AND ENACTING A NEW ORDINANCE WITHIN THE CITY OF CLINTON, STATE OF MINNESOTA

In order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Clinton, the Clinton City Council hereby repeals Ordinance No. 01-10 dealing with public nuisances and hereby enacts a new Ordinance in its place to deal specifically with weeds and overgrown grass. The new Ordinance covers the following topics: city jurisdiction; definition of terms; owners responsible for trimming, removal, and the like; filing a complaint; notice of violations; appeals by residents; abatement by the city; and liability for an abatement.

A violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1000) and/or up to ninety (90) days of jail.

This summary is being published in compliance with Minnesota Statues Section 331A.01, Subdivision 10 and Minnesota Statutes Section 412.191, Subdivision 4. A copy of the full text of this Ordinance shall be available at regular office hours of the office of the Clinton City Clerk. The full text of this Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
