

**ORDINANCE NO. 10-97**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW WITHIN  
THE CITY OF CLINTON, MINNESOTA AND  
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 11**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CLINTON, MINNESOTA,** that Ordinance No. 11 be and is hereby repealed to read as follows:

**Section 1: Curfew:** No person under the sixteen (16) years of age may be, loiter, or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys or public places in the City of Clinton between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, inclusive; and between the hours of 11:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday.

**Section 2: Exceptions:** This curfew does not apply to:

- (A) a person accompanied by a parent or legal guardian;
- (B) a person accompanied by the employer of such child or ward;
- (C) a person in the performance of an errand or duty directed by the person's parent, guardian or other proper legal custodian.

**Section 3: Parental Responsibility:** A parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care and custody of a person under age 16 years of age may not allow or permit that child, ward or other person under such age to go or be, or loiter or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys or public places in the City of Clinton between the hours as set forth in Section 1 above.

**Section 4: Violations:** Police officers of the City of Clinton may arrest, without warrant, a person violating the provisions of this Ordinance. A minor violating the provisions of this Ordinance will be guilty of a petty misdemeanor.

ORDINANCE NO. 11

Be it ordained by the Village of Clinton, Minnesota, that Chapter 9:09 of the Clinton Municipal Code of 1951 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 9:09 - CURFEW

Any parent, or legal guardian, who fails to prevent any child, or ward, of his who is under the age of eighteen to be or loiter upon any of the public streets, sidewalks, alleys, or public grounds of this village between the hours of 10:00 o'clock P.M. and 6:00 A.M., unless accompanied by or under the control of such parent, guardian, the employer of such child or ward, or some other person who is more than twenty-one years of age, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Likewise, any parent or legal guardian who allows his child, or ward, to make undue noise so as to disturb the peace and quiet of this village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

This ordinance shall be in full force in effect immediately after its passage and publication.
