

SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE - Number 10-05

The following are regulations for the operation of snowmobiles within the City of Clinton.

1. No person under the age of 14 years shall operate a snowmobile in the City except on his own property. Snowmobile operators from 14 to 18 years of age must have snowmobile Training Certificate to cross village streets, county roads, or state highways. Persons of 12 years and older may operate a snowmobile if there is an adult (18 years and older) riding with them.
2. Snowmobiles shall not be operated on any City street or alley except on the marked and designated exit routes out of the City.
3. Snowmobiles shall not be operated anywhere in the City between the hours of 12:00 pm and 7:00 am.
4. Unnecessary noise and operation of machines with improper or faulty mufflers is forbidden.
5. Persons owning snowmobiles may drive them from their homes by the most direct route to the nearest access route, but only for the purpose of leaving or entering the city. Use of access routes as an inside-the-village track will not be tolerated.
6. Absolutely no driving on private property...THIS IS CONSIDERED TRESPASSING!
